wind

This day begins with a fine breeze from
E by N with fine weather Steering by
the wind heading S E. saw a Steamer
Steering off W N W. Middle & last part
light airs and calms with squally
weather

This day begins with a calm with
squalls of rain Middle & last part
light airs and calms with squalls of
rain and thunder & lightning

S E by E. with squally weather
Middle & last part calm with cloudy
weather

with cloudy weather Middle & last
part light breeze from S E. heading
E by N

Lat 31°36' N
Long 50°54' W

Thursday Sept 16

This day begins with a light air
from S E with pleasant weather
Steering by the wind heading E by N
Middle & last part light breeze
from S E with fine weather heading
E by N

Lat 32°18' N
Long 49°49' W

Friday Sept 17

This day begins with a fine breeze
from S E with pleasant weather
heading E by N saw a Steamer
and Ship Steering to Westward
Middle & last part fine breeze from
S E with pleasant weather
