

Remarks on Board Schooner E. H. Hatfield

Tuesday Sept 21 1880

This day begins with a fresh gale from N.W. with cloudy weather laying by the whale two tow lines fast to the whale Mordle & last part blowing fresh from N by E.

Lat 32° 48' N
Long 49° 40' W

Wednesday Sept 22

at 12 Mid day more moderate commenced to cut the whale at 6 P.M. finished cutting the Body to brought to cut the head at 9 P.M. commenced to Boil Mordle & last part more moderate Mordle & last part all hands employed in Boiling and cutting up the whale

Thursday Sept 23 Lat 32° 12' N
Long 49° 51' W

This day begins with a moderate breeze with a heavy swell on all hands employed in Boiling and cutting up the whale Mordle & last part calm with a heavy swell on at 6 A.M. commenced to cut the head found it Bad Blasted

Lat 31° 40' N
Long 49° 54' W
