and set Bysail and steered S W by W  
at 11 were ship to the northward at  
daylight were ship and steered S W by W

E at 1 P M saw Rum bar bearing W by E  
Dist 20 Mile at sundown tooket ship to

part at daylight kept off S W the Anctorage  
at noon let go the Anctorage in 4 fathoms of  
water incampney with the Emma Jane

Friday Dec 24<sup>th</sup>
