

Remarks on board Sigsbee E. H. Hatfield of Edgartown
Saturday Dec 25th

All these 24 hours lying at anchor at
Rum Key with fine weather

Sunday Dec 26th
First part of these 24 hours lying at
anchor Middle part the same latter part
at daylight got underway with a light
breeze from the Southward the Emma Jane
in company

Monday Dec 27th
First part of these 24 hours light breeze and fine
weather Middle part the same latter part
at daylight got underway with a light
breeze from the Southward at noon
Rum Key bearing S E 8 miles distant

Tuesday Dec 28th
First part of these 24 hours light haffling
wind and squally from various points
and Matting's Island bearing W 10 miles
distant at 4 P.M. heavy rain steering W to pass
the Island Middle part light breeze and
rain from the W steering E W latter
part light breeze and fine weather bear-
ing by the wind to the W W the Emma
Jane in company

Lat 24 = 59 W
Long 73 = 42 W

Wednesday Dec 29th
First part of these 24 hours light breeze
from the W W heading by the wind to the
W E at 2 P.M. sand blasted fish barrels and
chased without success Middle and latter
part light airs and calm

Lat 24 = 57 W
Long 73 = 42 W

Thursday Dec 30th

All these 24 hours light airs and calm
from various points heading to the W
W the Emma Jane in company

Lat 24 = 59 W
Long 73 = 42 W

Friday Dec 31st
First part of these 24 hours Moderate breeze
from the W E steering W W by W Middle part
the same latter part fresh breeze employed
at breaking out for water and provisions
two sails in sight

Lat 25 = 41 W
Long 74 = 44 W

Saturday Jan 1st 1881
All these 24 hours fresh breeze
from the W E steering W W the Emma
Jane in company

Lat 25 = 36 W
Long 75 = 36 W

Sunday Jan 2nd
First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze
and fine weather steering W W at sundown
shortened sail Middle part wind hauling
to the W latter part at daylight made sail
and heeled to the W E from 7 to 9 o'clock
thick and rainy have too at 10 clear
head by the wind to the W E at noon
overcast

No sail

Monday Jan 3rd
First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze
from the W W heading by the wind to
the E W at sundown shortened sail Middle
part the same latter part at 2 P.M. wind
E W wore ship to the W at daylight
made all sail

Lat 27 = 38 W
Long 75 = 05 W
