

Remarks on board Scho. E. off Hatfield of Edgartown
Sunday Feb 27th

First part of these 24 hours light breeze from the W steering down along the coast to the S W about two miles from the shore Middle part light baffling winds from various points latter part at daylight wind commenced breezing from the S E weather thick and overcast and barometer falling tackled ship and started E or E by N Cape Bear at noon strong breeze and raining so cold

Monday Feb 28th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the S E and rain steering E or E at 6 P M came to anchor off part Caswell's Middle part strong breeze and heavy rain latter part the same

Tuesday March 1st

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the S W Middle and latter part the same lying at anchor

Wednesday March 2nd

First of these 24 hours strong breeze from the W still at anchor Middle part the same latter part at 8 P M got underway with a fine breeze from the W and steered out side of the Bar

Thursday March 3rd

First part of these 24 hours moderate breeze from the S W cruising outside of the Bar at 5 P M came in to anchor Middle part the same latter part at 9 P M got underway with a light breeze from the E and steered outside

Friday March 4th

First part of these 24 hours light breeze from the S E at 1 P M came in thick fog came in and anchored Middle part wind S and rain latter part a gale from the S W employed at breaking out beef & Pork &c

Saturday March 5th

First part of these 24 hours commenced with a gale from the S W still at anchor Middle and latter parts the same

Sunday March 6th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from the W S W still at anchor Middle and latter part the same

Monday March 7th

First part of these 24 hours calm Middle part the same latter part light breeze from the W W at daylight got underway and steered outside

Tuesday March 8th

First part of these 24 hours moderate breeze from the W W cruising outside and waiting at 5 P M came to anchor Middle part the same latter part wind W E got underway and steered outside of the Bar

Wednesday March 9th

First part these 24 hours cruising outside of the Bar at three P M wind S E and squally came into anchor Middle part the same latter part strong breeze from the S W at anchor
