

Remark onboard Sch. E. H. Hatfield of Edgartown
Monday March 28th

First part of these 24 hauls fresh breeze from the W. S. W. Cruising out side at 2 P.M. commenced breezing and came into anchor Middle part the same latter part calm sent one boat crew a waaling

Tuesday March 29th

First part of these 24 hauls light air from the S. E. still lying at anchor one boat and shore waaling at 3 P.M. the boat returned having cut two boat loads Middle part wind breezing from from the S. W. and weather threatening & barometer very low 29.4 tenth latter part blowing a heavy gale from the S. W. let go the starboard anchor

Wednesday March 30th

First part of these 24 hauls blowing a gale from the S. W. Middle & latter part the same

Thursday March 31st

First part of these 24 hauls blowing a gale from the S. W. Middle part moderating latter part strong breeze from the S. W. at 8 P.M. had visitor by an officer of the U. S. Revenue Steamer Calfax who came aboard to investigate a report having been sent to him that we were cruelly treated but found it to be a false statement

Friday April 1st

First part of these 24 hauls strong breeze from the S. W. remaining at anchor Middle & latter part the same broke out for Reef & Park

Saturday Apr 2nd

First part of these 24 hauls a gale from the W. S. W. still lying at anchor at 3 P.M. blowing violently the vessel dragged her anchor and went aground and remained so until 10 P.M. when we came off with assistance of a tugboat without damage whatever Middle part moderating same latter part got under way with a fresh breeze from the S. W. and stood out as far as the eye being the wind breezing and came back and anchored

Sunday Apr 3rd

First part of these 24 hauls strong breeze from the W. S. W. still lying at anchor too rugged to go outside Middle part the same latter part the same this day Mr. Augustus Sartan was married to Miss Eliza J. Simmons

Monday Apr 4th

First part of these 24 hauls strong breeze from the S. W. Middle part the latter part a gale from the S. and raining
