

Remarks on board Scho E Hatfield of Edgarton  
Tuesday Apr 26<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hands all hands employed at setting up shacks and taking in Fresh Water

Wednesday Apr 27<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hands all hands employed at standing the lake and filling Fresh Water at 3 PM the Capt came from Weymouth bringing four Men that he had shipped latter part employed at setting up the lead riggin and sent the Bark tapmast

Thursday Apr 28<sup>th</sup>

First part of these light winds from the S and rain employed at various jobs about the ship latter part at a fine breeze and fine weather from the W at daylight got under way and came down the River and anchored off Ball's Head

Friday Apr 29<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hands employed at taking aboard Maat at 4 PM Simsbury and 5 PM the Boat went ashore to ca. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Mate & Trip when three of the crew deserted from the Boat A. S. of Weymouth Joseph & Stephen

Boat remains ashore all night owing to a thick fog latter part at 7 PM the Boat returned aboard thick fog and light air from the S.W.

Saturday Apr 30

First part of these 24 hands light air and thick fog at 6 PM wind hauling to the W and clearing up latter part at daylight the Capt started for Weymouth to ship more men

Sunday May 1<sup>st</sup>

First part of these 24 hands strong breeze from the W at 7 PM the Capt the returned bringing Men with him that had shipped latter part calm & gentle

Monday May 2<sup>nd</sup>

First part of these light breeze from the W.W. at 4 PM got underway and stood out side to wait for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Mate that we had sent a Boat for at 6 PM the Boat returned bringing the 2<sup>nd</sup> Mate made all sail and started S by E at 10 PM light breeze from the S saw the Flying Dan light ship bearing W by N 5 miles East latter part calm

Tuesday May 3<sup>rd</sup>

First part of these 24 hands calm at 1 PM at a light breeze from S at 3 PM passed the light ship and kept off W by N for Beaufort latter part the same
