Remarks on Board Sunday Jan the 8th 1854

Commenced with moderate trades and fine weather steering S by E. at 4 P.M. changed her course to S by E 1/2 E. Latter part fresh trades from the E & E took in the light sail and 2 sails steering it to the westward. Barometer 29 1/2 for closure Sabbath with prayer as usual.

Sat 22-57 Song 21-57

Remarks on Board Monday Jan the 9th 1854

Commenced with fresh trades from the E & E steering S by E 1/2 E at 3 1/2 P.M. Doubled Reefed the Main sail Barometer 29 1/2 Latter part the trades very fresh steering S by E 1/2 E

Sat 20 17 Song 20-02

Sch. E. Nickerson Cruising off the Porcupine Bank
Remarks on Board Tuesday Jan 10th 1854

Commenced with very fresh trades from the N.E. steering S by E under 2 Reefed Fore sail and 1/2 with the 3rd Bonnet off. at 3 P.M. Bluffed her on the Eastern Bank, and shortened sail and set Reebars watches for the first time. O may Gods blessing attend us in all we do, and may he give us grace to do all things in his fear and to his honour and glory, so that we can call on him at all times in faith believing that he will do all things well. Barometer 29 1/2 Latter part very fresh trades from the N.E. at 6 1/2 A.M. set the 1/2. Standing to the S.E. under 2 Reefed Fore sail and 1/2 till 11 A.M. ends

Sat 19-03 Song 19-59

Remarks on Board Wednesday Jan 11th 1854

Commenced with very fresh trades from the N.E. standing to the wind to the S.E. under 2 Reefed Fore sail and 1/2 till 3 P.M. took in the 1/2. Barometer 29 1/2 Latter part the same at 6 1/2 A.M. set the 1/2 and wore it to the Northern at 8 1/2 took in the 1/2
