 Remarks On Board Saturday Feb 11th

Commences with light trades and clouds.
 Employed in Repairing the fishing gear
 and bending it and the Outer Jib.
 at 6 P M Came to anchor.
 Latter part light winds and fair
 from the S W to E ends

Remarks On Board Sunday Feb 12th

First part light airs from the
 N to W at 5th shortened sail the
 vessel headed off shore. Saw
 Porpoises and a fish. A sea look
 on us in. Wore this day and may we
 try to live better than we have done
 the past. I feel that I would like
 to be at home with my friends. Oh God
 I feel that I am a great sinner. Latter
 part light winds from the S W to E
 saw 1 Black Bird and porpoises
 So Ends with Prayer as usual

 Remarks On Board Monday Feb 13th

First part light dis. from the Northward
 and very fine weather. Latter part
 the same at 9 A M lowered for Black
 Fish at 10 Returned to the vessel
 at 11 saw a Sam of Blump Backs
 at 12^{1/2} lowered for them Boat got
 nothing at 3^{1/2} lowered again for
 a Blow and calf in the S Boat
 Struck an. Parked.



Remarks On Board Tuesday Feb 14th

First part fine weather the wind
 S W to at 3^{1/2} P M lowered for
 Blump Backs but did not strike and
 parked at 7 P M shortened sail
 and stood off from the land
 Latter part very fine at 8 lowered
 for Blump Backs but did not
 strike at 9 lowered again
 without success
 So Ends
