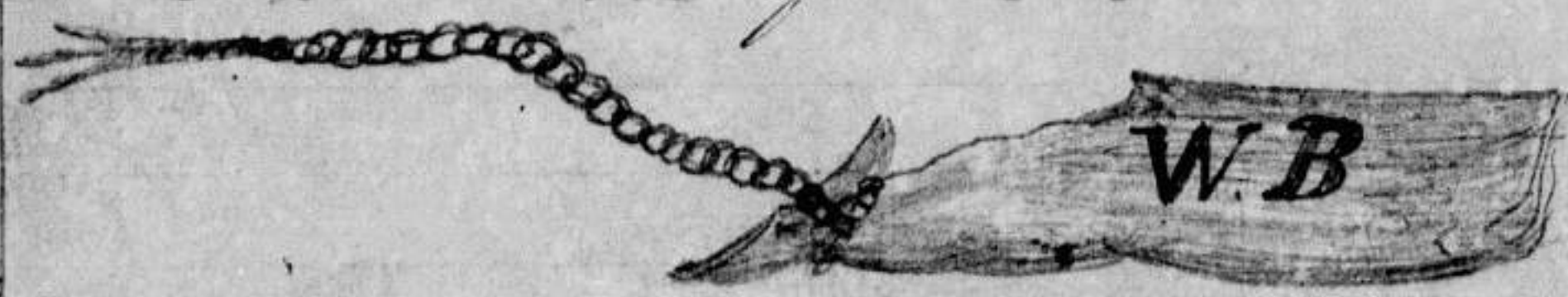


Schooner E. Nickerson off Sal
18th 1854
Remarks on Board Saturday March

Commences with moderate trades
Employed in Stowing off the Hold and
washing off Decks. at 3 saw
Black Fish. at 6:15 came to
Anchor. at 5:15 A. M. got under
way. But saw nothing. Put her away
for Bonavista at 7:15 saw it. at 8:15 saw
the Brig.

Remarks on Board Sunday March 19th 1854

Commences with moderate trades
Starting for Bonavista at 2:15 P.M.
saw the Brig. September take a whale
along side. at 3 saw a can of H.B.
and lowered for them. the H.B.
struck at 5 took him along side.
and he parted the fluke rope
and sunk. 6 saw what will come
next at 6:15 came to anchor on the
S.W. side of the Island.

Remarks on Board Monday March 20th

Commences with moderate trades at
5:15 A.M. got under way at 6 lowered
for H.B. Decks but struck none
the S Boat struck and took a
Porpoise to the vessel.



At Ends

Remarks on Board Tuesday March 21st 1854

Commences with moderate trades at
1:15 P.M. lowered for H.B. Decks the
S Boat struck and lowered
at 6 P.M. came to anchor. at 5:15
A.M. got under way. at 8 lowered
for H.B. Decks at 10:15 the S Boat
struck in the whales small at
12:15 lowered it was impossible
to haul up. It appears sometimes
to me that it is rather hard luck.
But as long as everything is done
that I can do I have a conscience
clear of all blame. I do not
know that I can do anything but
keep trying and trust in God for
the remainder.
