Remarks On Board Monday April 10th 1854

Commenced with trades - lying at Anchor.
at 5¹/₂ A M got under way at beat
around the Island to see if I could find
the Coro and calf. But could not.
So Ends

Remarks On Board Tuesday April 11th 1854

Commenced with moderate trades. at
3 P M lowered for 10 Backs at 3³/₄ the
10 Boat struck one in the small.
he ran up the 10 side of the
Island among the Reefs so that it
was not safe to work the vessel after
him in the night and I set collours
for him to cut and come on Board.
But he would not. Somewhere about
dark he drewed the Iron wire 9¹/₂
Returned to the vessel at 7 the vessel
came to Anchor. at 5¹/₂ A M got under
way. at 9 lowered for 10 Back the 10 Boat
struck at 10¹/₂ took her along side. at 11
commenced cutting.
So Ends

Remarks On Board Wednesday April 12th 1854

Commenced with moderate trades.
Employed cutting at 1¹/₂ P M finished
at 5 P M came to
Anchor in 8 fathoms of water at 6
finished clearing the Deck and got tea.
at 5¹/₂ A M hove up the Anchor at
6¹/₂ lowered at 8 the 10 Boat struck.
and killed the whale at 8¹/₂ took her
along side. at 10¹/₂ commenced cutting. at
11 saw the Brig September
So Ends

Remarks On Board Thursday April 13th

Commenced with fresh trades. Employed
cutting in. at 2 P M finished cutting.
at 6 P M came to Anchor in 8 fathoms of
water. at 6¹/₂ the Capt of the Brig came
on Board. at 9 set quarter watches to
cut the Blubber. at 5 A M started
the works saw no whales at
9 put on a Springer so that
the works clear spoke
