Remarks on Board Thursday April 14th 1854

Commenced with fresh trades Employed Boiling at 2 P.M. saw the September Board fast to a whale. Latter the same Employed Boiling and getting ready to Stow Down. Saw some Brakes.

Remarks on Board Saturday April 15th 1854

Commenced with fresh trades Employed Boiling. at 5:12 P.M. finished at 5:12 A.M. got under way at 9 finished Stowing Down and Hoisted off.

Remarks on Board Sunday April 16th 1854

Commenced with fresh trades at 4:12 P.M. came to Anchor in 8 fathoms of water. in company with the Brig September. Latter part the same saw a number of whales at 8 A.M. saw some near the stern that some one of them forward had thrown overboard.

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Remarks on Board Monday April 17th 1854

Commenced with fresh trades Lying at Anchor at 5:12 got under way at 7:12 lowered for the Backs the Boat went along side of On and the Boat Steerer missed a good chance. at 10 Returned to the vessel at 11 made sail for the Isle of Sal.

Remarks on Board Tuesday April 18th 1854

Commenced with fresh trades Standing off On the Tack at 3 P.M. tacked On at 5:12 tacked off again the Brainer Hull Point Barking N by E Dist 4 miles at 10:12 A.M. raised the Sails of Sal Reared N by E Dist 15 miles

Remarks on Board Wednesday April 19th 1854

Commenced with moderate trades at 4 P.M. lowered for the Backs the Boat struck and drew the Boat then struck and killed him at 7 took him along side at 8:12 commenced cutting at 10:12 finished and made sail at 9 A.M. lowered for the Backs But did not get near
