Remarks on Board Sunday May 28th 1854

Commences with light trades from the
ESE steering to S to. with a
Bark in sight steering to S.
This is the Sabbath Day or Eve. and
I feel that I have felt far short of
serving God as I ought the past
week. I must be better the week to come.
I should much enjoy this day at home.
But with God blessing I hope to be
where I can hear Gods word preached
before long. Latter part the same as
of A. M. Saw a Bark steering by to
the Northward.

Remarks on Board Monday May 29th

Commences with moderate Breezes from the
ESE steering to S to. at 6 P.M. saw
a ship steering by to the Northward.
Latter part Breeze. Employed getting the
Rigging.
