Remarks on Board Wednesday June 14th 1854

Commenced with light Breeze from the
southerly, at 1st the wind hauled
to the westward. Employed painting
latter part light air from the
westward and foggy. Lat 36 Long 69-15

Remarks on Board Thursday June 15th

Commenced with light air from the S to
and foggy. At 4 P. M. sounded a
36 fathoms of water fine white
sand. at 6 lowered the S Boat and
I made out on Board a Brigg from
Bath Maine Bound to Virginia. at 7
sounded and got 35 fathoms, coarse
gray sand. Latter part foggy with
light winds from the S to
Lat 36-36 Long 69-32

Remarks on Board Friday June 16th 1854

Commenced with light winds from the S to
steering S by E spoke 2 fisherman
