Singular property of figures.

If a Multiplicand be found formed of the
 Digits in their regular Order, Omitting the 9,
 A Multiplier may be found by a rule, which
 will give a product, each figure of which shall
 be the same. Thus if 12345679 be given, and
 it be required to find a Multiplier which shall
 give the product all in 2, that Multiplier
 will be 18: if in 3, the Multiplier will be 27: if all
 in 4, it will be 36 — and so forth.

The rule by which the Multiplier is discovered is
 this: — Multiply the last figure (the 9) of the Multiplicand
 by the figure of which you wish the product to be
 composed, and that number will be the required
 Multiplier. Thus, when it was required to have
 the product composed of 2, the 9 multiplied by 2
 gives 18, the Multiplier: 3 multiplied by 9 gives 27,
 and so on to the End
