

Monday March 3th



SB

Commenced with light airs from the N.E. at 4 P.M. boats returned on board, and saw more whales, at 5.30 P.M. boards and struck a large whale and got him too the ship, at day light commenced cutting, so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs. 43.40 long 55.06

Tuesday March 4th

Commenced with fresh breeze from N.W. at 2 P.M. got the head off at 7.30 finish cutting in the body and junk, lay by the case at night, at 8 A.M. got the case in and steered by the wind to the eastward, so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs. 42.30 longitude 55.44

Wednesday 5th

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.E. steering by the wind to the N.E. middle and latter part light breezes from N.E. so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs. 43.16 long 55.54

Thursday 6th



Commenced with fresh breezes from N.E. at 3 P.M. saw 4 large sperm whales going to the southward, board and struck one he sounded and ran back at sund but from him and let him go, at 6 A.M. saw a large sperm whale going quick to the south chased to all day with ship and boats but could not get up with him, so ends latitude by Obs. 43.46 long 55.07



Friday 7th



Commenced with strong breezes from the N.E. at 6 P.M. give up chasing the whale, and steered by the wind to the westward, middle part the same latter part strong gale from N.W. at 6.40 A.M. saw a large sperm whale bounds to the north, too eager to lose the boat for him, so ends No observation latitude by Obs. 43.40 long 55.06

Saturday 8th

Commenced with strong breezes from the N.W. at 4 P.M. wind hauled out N.W. at 4.30 P.M. wore ship and headed to the north, middle and latter part light air and calm, at 9 A.M. saw a large sperm whale bounds to the westward, board after him and got him, so ends these 24 hours, boats off towing, latitude by Obs. 43.44 long 55.40

Sunday 9th

Commenced with light air from the N.E. at 2.40 P.M. got the whale a tongue of the ship, and showed down some of the oil of the whale between decks, middle part the same latter part strong breezes and thick foggy weather, at noon finished cutting in the body, so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs. 43.54

Monday 10th

Commenced with strong breezes from the north, at 5 P.M. finished cutting the whale middle and latter part the same so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs. 44.11 long 55.58
