

Wednesday April 23th Commenced with moderate breezes from the S.W. steering N.W. by middle and latter part the same, at 7 A.M. saw 3 sails standing to the Northward so ends these 24 hours latitude by Observation 40° 09

Thursday 24th Commenced with light breezes from the S.W. and fine weather steering N.W. by middle and latter part light airs, at daylight saw the Island of Mocha bearing S.W. by distant 8 leagues, at 10 A.M. saw eight or ten by board after them and chased them several hours but of no use they were too slow for us, so ends these 24 hours No Observation

Friday 25th Commenced with light breezes from S.W. at 4 P.M. the Island 3 miles distant saw eight whales boards and chased them but of no avail, tucked about during the night, at 8 A.M. saw a Chilean Sea bound down the coast, at 11 P.M. board a boat and went on shore after vegetables, so ends these 24 hours

Saturday 26th Commenced with light breezes from the S.W. at 7 P.M. boat returned with meat and potatoes and stood off S.W. by at 7 A.M. saw St. Marys bearing E. Dist. 15 mi at 10 A.M. Calm, so ends these 24 hours

Monday June 2th Commenced with light breezes from the south, steering N.W. by middle and latter part light breezes, saw finbacks, so ends these 24 hours, latitude by Obs, 24° 05

Tuesday June 3rd Commenced with brisk breezes from the south, middle and latter part light breezes, at 10 A.M. past a bark beating up the coast, so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs, 22° 33

Wednesday 4th Commenced with light breezes from the south at 7 P.M. Calm, middle part the same latter part light airs, so ends these 24 hours latitude by Observation 21° 52

Thursday 5th Commenced with light airs from the south, steering N.W. by middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs, 20° 45

Friday 6th Commenced with light airs from the south, steering N.W. by middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours No Observations
