

Monday 14th

Commenced with moderate trades and fine weather, Steer'd North saw the Land, at noon Juyta head 25 miles distant, so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday 17th

Commenced with fresh trades and fine weather, at 6 P.M. stood in of the Harbour and tacked off at 7 tacked in, the Capt of the port came off, at 8 P.M. went on shore with him, at 8 A.M. the ship returned in the bay laying off and on, so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday 18th

Commenced with moderate trades, at 5 P.M. boat returned and stood off W.P.M. saw hump backs so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs 4° 13' longitude 82° 25'

Thursday 19th



Commenced with moderate trades, at 10.40 P.M. saw breches which proved to be a shoal of sperm whales, board after them struck three and got two, at 5 P.M. got the whales a longside of the ship and prepared for cutting them, at 10.30 P.M. parted the flock chain from one of them board two boats and took him a longside of the ship, at daylight commenced cutting at 10 A.M. finished, saw breches off the weather beam, so ends these 24 hours, latitude by Obs, 3° 45'

Friday June 20th

Commenced with moderate trades and pleasant weather, at 1 P.M. tacked to the westward, at midnight tacked in, at 7 A.M. tacked off, saw plenty of blackfish, so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs, 3° 44'

Saturday 21th

Commenced with moderate trades and fine weather, employed in sailing middle and latter part moderate breezes, at day light saw a whale bark a head standing in shore, so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs, 3° 31'

Sunday 22th

Commenced with light trades and thick weather, saw blackfish middle part the same latter part light air and clear weather so ends these 24 hours, latitude by Obs, 3° 41'

Monday 23th

Commenced with light air and pleasant weather, at 4 P.M. saw blackfish board and got 5, lay a back headed for the westward during the night, at 7 A.M. were swift and steer'd N.E., so ends these 24 hours latitude by Observation 3° 13' longitude 83° 48'
