

Tuesday June 24th Commencis with fresh trades
and fine weather, saw finbacks
and blackfish, at 7 A.M. wore ship
and steer'd, 11 by 5, so ends these
24 hours, latitude by Obs 14° 45'

Wednesday 25th Commencis with fresh trades and
cloudy weather, middle and
cattar part the same, so ends
these 24 hours, latitude by
Observation, 14° 7' long 85° 55'

Thursday 26th Commencis with strong trades,
steering 11 by 8, middle and
cattar part the same, so ends
these 24 hours latitude
by Observation, 56 miles

Friday 27th Commencis with moderate
trades and pleasant weather,
at 1 P.M. saw the S.E. End
of Chatham Island bearing
N.W. at 4 P.M. Larkup top
the eastward, at 2 A.M. hooked
to the south, at 11 A.M. anchored
at Woods Island, to smoke the
ship, sent one boat on shore
and got 3 small Terrapin, so
ends these 24 hours, 1, 3, 1, 1

Commencis with moderate trades
with some light rain, at 8 A.M.
took the anchor and steer'd off
for Charles Islands, so ends these
24 hours

Wednesday 2nd

Commencis with moderate trades
at 6 P.M. steer'd 11 by 8, saw the
town of Charles Islands, found no
ship at anchor at this island
at daylight steer'd off for South Head
at noon south head bore East 3
miles distant, so ends these 24
hours

Thursday 3rd

Commencis with fresh trades and
pleasant weather, saw 4 ships
off North Head, so ends these
24 hours

Friday 4th

Commencis with moderate breezes
and pleasant weather, at 3 P.M.
spoke the following ships, No. 10
11 months out, 366 bbls on board
Weeper 28th months out, 800 bbls
Oliver Adams, 37 months out, 2400 bbls
so ends these 24 hours

Saturday 5th

Commencis with moderate trades
and pleasant weather, at 6 P.M.
spoke ship Lafayette 10 months
out 200 bbls at 8 P.M. spoke ship
Lyle 8 months out 200 bbls,
at 8 A.M. steer'd off for Kingston
so ends these 24 hours, a plenty of
ships and no whales
