

Thursday July 6th

Commenced with moderate trades and pleasant weather, steering E N E, middle and latter part strong trades, at 7 P.M. put 2 ships standing to the eastward signalled one of them showing a signal blue white and blue length ways, so ends there 24 hours, latitude by obs 1.22 North

Monday 7th

Commenced with fresh trades, steering E by N at 7 A.M. wore ship and stood N by N so ends there 24 hours latitude by obs, 1.55 North

Tuesday 8th

Commenced with strong trades and fine weather, steering by the wind to the south, so ends there 24 hours latitude by observation, 2.20 North

Wednesday 9th

Commenced with strong breezes at 5 P.M. saw fin like took them to be sperm whales, but soon found out the middle and latter part strong breezes, so ends there 24 hours latitude by observation 3.01 North

Thursday 10th

Commenced with strong breezes at 4 P.M. a large tree off the weather beam, backed and stood towards it to find out for a certainty whether it was a tree or not at 5 P.M. backed back to the N.W. middle and latter part strong breezes and a strong N.E. current, so ends there 24 hours latitude by obs 3.05 North long 95.20

Friday 11th

Commenced with strong trades, steering by the wind to the south middle part the same, latter part more moderate, so ends there 24 hours latitude by obs, 1.50 N long 97.30

Saturday 12th



Commenced with fresh trades and pleasant weather, at 8 P.M. saw a shoal of sperm whales going to the N.W. at 4.30 P.M. backed after them struck one and got him at daylight Commenced cutting at 7 A.M. finished and stood by the wind to the south, so ends there 24 hours latitude by obs 1.42 North

Sunday 13th

Commenced with strong trades, steering by the wind to the south middle and latter part the same, at daylight Commenced boiling the whale, so ends there 24 hours, latitude by obs, 41 miles North long 101.17
