

Wednesday July 23th Commencis with strong breezes and squally with some rain. at 2 P.M. finished cutting, at 5.40 P.M. were round to the N.E., middle and latter part strong winds and rugged, so ends Employed in boiling latitude by Obs. 45° 45'

Thursday 24th Commencis with strong gale and rugged, scarcely by the wind to the N.E. middle part the same latter part more moderate, at midnight finished boiling, at 24 hours latitude by Obs. 40° 42'

Friday 25th Commencis with fresh trades and clear weather, at 6 P.M. were ship to the south, at 8 P.M. signalized ship Constitution of Nantucket standing to the N.E., so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs. 5° 2'

Saturday 26th Commencis with strong trades and clear weather, at 6 P.M. were ship to the N.E., at 9 P.M. were ship to the south, and commenced showing down ~~the~~ of the oil, so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs. 5° 17' longitude 76° 59'

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Sunday 27th Commencis with fresh trades, at 4.30 P.M. spoke ship Constitution of Nantucket 24 months out, 800 bls, at 7 P.M. were ship to the N.E., so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs. 4° 45'

Monday 28th Commencis with fresh trades and clear weather, at 3 P.M. were ship to the south, middle and latter part strong winds, at noon saw the Constitution, so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs. 5° 37'

Tuesday 29th Commencis with strong winds and rugged, at 1 P.M. were ship to the N.E. under doubled reefed topsails, middle and latter part strong breezes, part the Constitution, so ends these 24 hours, latitude by Obs. 4° 45' long 76° 53'

Wednesday 30th Commencis with strong breezes at 6 P.M. were ship to the southward, middle and latter part strong trades, so ends these 24 hours latitude by Obs. 5° 34'

Thursday 31th Commencis with strong trades at 6 P.M. tacked to the N.E., the Constitution in sight off the sea beam, middle and latter part moderate breezes and fine weather, saw nothing so ends these 24 hours, latitude by Obs. 5° 21' about
