

Wednesday Oct 8th

Commenced with strong breezes and rugged, steering by the wind to the eastward, at 6 A.M. wore ship to the south, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Observation 2.33 Long 91.34

Thursday 9th

Commenced with fresh trades and clear weather, middle and latter part light breezes, at 6 A.M. saw Vulture and Hennans Islands, at noon tacked to the eastward, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 1.52 North

Friday 10th

Commenced with fresh breezes and cloudy weather, middle part the same, latter part more moderate, at 6 A.M. tacked to the south, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 1.23 North

Saturday 11th

Commenced with fresh trades and cloudy weather, middle part the same, latter part strong breezes, at 7 A.M. sent one boat on shore at Hennans Island after fish, at 10 returned with boat loaded, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 1.21

Sunday 12th

Commenced with strong trades, at 2 P.M. saw Abington Island bearing S by S by Compass, middle part calm, latter part light breezes from south to SW, with some rain, at 10 A.M. tacked to the north, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 57 miles North

Monday Oct 13th

Commenced with light airs and clear weather, at 2.40 P.M. tacked to the S, Abington 27 miles distant bearing S by E by Compass, tacked about during the night, working up too it, at 8 A.M. sent two boats on shore after tarrafin, so ends these 24 hours,

Tuesday 14th

Commenced with moderate breezes and fine weather, at 3.30 P.M. boats returned with 3 dead ones and three live ones, steered off S by E, at 6 A.M. saw the rock, so ends these 24 hours Calm

Wednesday 15th

Commenced with a calm the rock 10 miles distant, middle and latter part light breezes, at noon saw a ship and one bark the ship a sailing, so ends these 24 hours

Thursday 16th

Commenced with light breezes, at 3 P.M. spoke ship Alfred Tyler of Edgartown, 350 bbls 10 1/2 months out, also bark Franklin of Boston 25 1/2 months out, 750 bbls, tacked about working up off south side, so ends these 24 hours

Friday 17th

Commenced with strong trades, tacked about to the best advantage, middle part more moderate, latter part strong breezes, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 44 miles South
