

Thursday Dec 25th Commences with moderate breezes and fine weather, steering 100° E, middle and latter part the same, so ends there 24 hours -

Friday 26th Commences with fresh trades and fine weather, middle and latter part the same, so ends there 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 1.34 North,

Saturday 27th Commences with fresh trades and fine weather, middle and latter part the same, at Noon steers by the wind to the South, so ends there 24 hours, Latitude by Obs 2.00 North Long, 98.38

Sunday 28th Commences with fresh breezes and clear weather, middle and latter part the same, so ends there 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 1.20 North

Monday 29th Commences with strong trades and clear weather, middle and latter part light breezes, so ends there 24 hours Latitude by Obs 42 miles North

Tuesday 30th Commences with light trades at 4.30 I saw a shoal of sperm whales going quick to the S.W., hoard after them but of no use, backed about in hopes of finding them again but saw nothing, so ends there 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 51 miles North Longitude 103.24

Wednesday Dec 31st Commences with fresh trades and light squalls of rain, steering by the wind to the South, middle part the same latter part light breezes, at 10 I struck a cowfish and parted the line, hoard a boat and got him, so ends there 24 hours, Latitude by Observation 5 miles South

Thursday Jan 1st 1846 Commences with light trades and fine weather, steering by the wind to the South, middle and latter part the same, so ends there 24 hours, Latitude by Obs 16 miles South

Friday 2nd Commences with light trades and fine weather, steering by the wind to the South, middle and latter part strong breezes, so ends there 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 1.34 South

Saturday 3rd Commences with strong trades and fine weather, middle and latter part the same, so ends there 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 3.17 Longitude 10.15

Sunday 4th Commences with strong trades and clear weather, middle and latter part the same, at Noon past a ship showing a blue signal with a white square or diamond, so ends there 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 4.57
