Observation 2.31 South

Monday 12th

Commencis with fresh trades
and fine weather, at sun
set took in sail and steerd
N.E. by N., at 9 PM saw a ship
tacked a boat during the night
at daylight steerd N.W.E., so
ends these 24 hours latitude
by Obs. 1.09 South Long 110.11

Tuesday 13th

Commencis with moderate breezes
and fine weather, steering N. by E
middle and latter part strong breezes
saw two finbacks, so ends these
24 hours latitude by Obs. 1.09 N
