

Monday 23th Commenced with fresh trades & 5.30. The whales alongside, parted from one of them in the night, and saved him. Employed in cutting in the whale, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 45 miles S

Tuesday 24th Commenced with fresh trades at 5 P.M. got the whale in, and commenced boiling at 8 P.M. wore ship to the south, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 32 miles south

Wednesday 25th Commenced with fresh trades and fine weather, middle and latter part light breezes, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 1.37 S

Thursday 26th Commenced with light air and calm, at Noon wore ship to the N.E. so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 2.22 South

Friday 27th Commenced with light air and calm, middle and latter part light breezes, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 2.07 Long 129.16

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Saturday 28th Commenced with light air, and calm, middle and latter part the same, Employed stowing the oil, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 1.49 S

Sunday March 1st Commenced with a calm, saw black fish, middle part light air with some rain, latter part squally, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 1.40 S

Monday 2nd Commenced with light breezes from the Eastward, middle and latter part the same, at 7 P.M. saw a sail, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 34 miles south

Tuesday 3rd Commenced with light air and fine weather, at 6 P.M. spoke ship Barkley of Nantucket 28 months out 700 Tons, stood to the south in company, at Noon Tacked to the North, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 1.29 South

Wednesday 4th Commenced with light breezes and fine weather, saw white water several times, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 4 miles South Longitude 129.17 Chro Guner 129.41
