

Sunday March 15th

Commencis with light breezes and fine weather at 6 P.M. tacked to the south middle and latter part light airs and calms, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 16 miles N

Monday 14th

Commencis with light airs, steering by the wind to the south, at 6 A.M. past a ship steering N.W. with studing sails out and main royal showing the American flag, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 45 miles south,

Tuesday 17th

Commencis with moderate breezes and fine weather, at 4 P.M. board one boat after black fish but saw no more of them, at 9 A.M. saw brees his, run for them and saw no more of them, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 2.16 South at Noon Tacked to the North

Wednesday 18th

Commencis with fresh trades and fine weather middle and latter part light breezes, at 9 P.M. saw a ship off the west bow, standing to the south, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 23 miles South

Thursday 19th

Commencis with light trades at 3 P.M. board after black fish but could not strike, at 5 P.M. spoke ship Mary of Nantucket 30 months out with 750 lbs of ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 51 miles South

Friday 20th

Commencis with light breezes from N.E., with some rain, Steered East, middle and latter part Wind E.N.E., so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 1.13 S Long 129.29

Saturday 21th

Commencis with moderate breezes from E.N.E., steering by the wind to the South at 3 A.M. tacked to the North, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 1.40 S Long 129.34

Sunday 22th

Commencis with light breezes with some rain, at 5 P.M. boarded the Mary, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 34 miles South

Monday 23th

Commencis with light breezes steering by the wind to the North East, middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 35 miles North Long 129.52
