

Monday May 11th

Commencis with light
trades and fine weather,
steering by the wind to the
south, Middle and Lattar
part the same, repaired
the jib and bent it again.
so ends these 24 hours, latitude
by Obs, 1° 57' Long 117° 48'

Tuesday 12th

Commencis with moderate
trades and fine weather,
steering by the wind to the
south, Middle and Lattar
part fresh breezes, unbent
the foresail to repair it,
so ends these 24 hours latitude
by Obs, 3° 49' South

Wednesday 13th

Commencis with strong
breezes, Loading at 8
at 6:30 A.M. wore ship
to the S.E., finished the
foresail and bent it,
so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs, 4° 45'
Longitude 118° 25'

Thursday 14th

Commencis with fresh
breezes and fine weather
at 2 A.M. tacked to the south
at 7 A.M. tacked to the east
ward, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs, 4° 11'
Longitude 118° 00'

Friday May 15th

Commencis with fresh trades
and fine weather, middle
and Lattar part light breezes
so ends these 24 hours, latitude
by Obs, 3° 05' Long 117° 00'

Saturday 16th

Commencis with light trades
and fine weather, steering
by the wind to the Eastward,
Middle and Lattar part the
same, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs, 1° 44' Long 116° 15'

Sunday 17th

Commencis with light breezes
and fine weather, at 9 A.M.
spoke ship Norman of Nantucket
11 months out 900 lbs. boiling
a large whale, so ends these
24 hours, latitude by Obs,
34 miles South Long 115° 45'

Monday 18th

Commencis with light breezes
at Midnight wore ship to
the South, at 10 A.M. spoke
ship Planter of Nantucket
1500, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs, 23 miles S
Long 116° 30'

Tuesday 19th

Commencis with light breezes
and fine weather, at 6 A.M.
wore ship to the S.E.
middle and Lattar part
the same, so ends these
24 hours, latitude
by Obs, 4 miles South
