Commenced with strong trade
at 3 P.M. saw a school of sperm
whales; board after them struck
one and got him, at 5 P.M.
got the whale a long side of
the ship, and lay by him during
the night, at daylight commenced
cutting at 7 P.M. finished
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs, 5° 16' Long 108° 5'

Saturday 30th

Commenced with fresh breezes
at 2 P.M. wore ship to the
S.W., middle and latter part
the same, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs, 5° 18' North

Sunday 31st

Commenced with fresh trades
at 3 P.M. finished boiling out
the whale, middle and latter
part strong trades, so ends these
24 hours Latitude by Obs
5° 04' Long 110° 00'

Monday June 1st

Commenced with strong trade
middle and latter part
moderate breezes, at 2 P.M.
wore ship to the Eastward,
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs, 4° 43' Long 109° 15'

Tuesday 2nd

Commenced with light breeze
at 2 P.M. backed to the S.W.
at 11.30 P.M. backed to the
Eastward, so ends these 24
hours, Latitude by Obs, 4° 56'
Longitude 108° 39'

Wednesday June 3rd

Commenced with moderate trades
and fine weather, middle
part squally with some rain
latter part strong breezes,
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs, 4° 56'

Thursday 4th

Commenced with strong breezes
head up E.S.E., middle and
latter part the same, so ends
these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs,
4° 08' North Long 104° 31'

Friday 5th

Commenced with strong breezes
head up E.S.E., middle and latter
part the same, so ends these 24
hours, Latitude by Obs, 3° 3' N
Longitude 102° 34'

Saturday 6th

Commenced with strong breezes
head up E.S.E., middle and latter
part the same, so ends these
24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 2° 25'
Longitude 100° 30'

Sunday 7th

Commenced with strong breezes
head up E by S, middle and
latter part more moderate
head up E by S, saw black
fish, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs, 2° 2' N
Longitude 98° 53'
