

Monday Sept 21th Commencis with moderate breeze
at 1 P.M. wore ship to the S.E., middle
and latter part strong breezes, at 10
P.M. backed to the Westward, at
daylight saw a shoal of sperm whales
close to the ship, boxed and shot
3 and got them, so ends these
24 hours, supposed latitude 2.18
N Long 79.50

Tuesday Sept 22 Commencis with light breeze
middle part strong breezes latter
part light breezes with rain -
At 4 P.M. Commenced cutting at
sun not finished cutting one
of the whales, at 10 P.M. finished
cutting and steered by the wind
to the S.E., so ends these 24 hours
No Obs.

Wednesday 23th Commencis with light breeze
head up from S.W. to S, at midday
wore ship to the Westward, at 7
P.M. wore ship to the S.E., so ends
these 24 hours, Latitude by
Obs. 2.40 N Long 79.38

Thursday 24th Commencis with light breeze
head up south, middle and latter
part squally with rain, at 2 P.M.
wore ship to the Westward
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs. 2.18 N

Friday 25th Commencis with light breeze head
up S.W., at 6 P.M. finished boiling
out the whales, 502 bbls, at 1 P.M.
wore ship to the Westward, at 7 P.M. wore
ship to the S.E., so ends, Lat. by Obs. 1.40 N

Saturday Sept 26 Commencis with fresh breezes, at 6
P.M. backed off, the land 3 miles
Distant, at 6 P.M. backed off, at 7
P.M. backed in, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs. 1.09 N

Sunday 27 Commencis with moderate breeze
at 4 P.M. sent one boat on shore at
Point Galera, at 6 P.M. boat returned
with Plantains and 2 hogs, at 7 P.M.
backed in, so ends these 24 hours -
Latitude by Obs. 50 miles North

Monday 28 Commencis with fresh breeze, head
up from S.W. to S.E., at 7 P.M. backed off,
at 7 P.M. backed in, Commenced breaking
out the fore hole to stow down the oil,
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by
Obs. 37 miles North

Tuesday 29 Commencis with moderate breezes,
at 7.30 P.M. backed off, at 7 P.M. backed
in, saw a ship off the weather beam
standing in, finished stowing the oil
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude 7 miles
North

Wednesday 30 Commencis with fresh breezes, at
1 P.M. backed off, at 4 P.M. broke
ship Hydaspy of New Bedford
16 months out 650 bbls 200 of it p.
at 4 P.M. backed in at 10 P.M. backed
off, at 7 P.M. backed in, so ends these
24 hours, Latitude by Observation
10 miles South
