

Thursday Oct 1<sup>st</sup> Commenced with fresh breezes  
working up the Coast to the best  
advantage, middle and latter  
the same, so ends these 24 hours  
Latitude by Obs. 18 miles south

Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> Commenced with moderate breezes,  
backed about to the best advantage  
beating up the Coast, so ends these  
24 hours, No Observation

Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> Commenced with light breezes, working  
up the Coast, to the best advantage  
middle and latter part the same  
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by  
Obs. 1. 22 South.

Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> Commenced with moderate breezes, stand  
to the S. E., middle and latter part  
the same, so ends these 24 hours -  
Latitude by Obs. 2. 27

Monday 5<sup>th</sup> Commenced with light breezes head  
up S. E.; saw blackfish, at Noon  
Came too at Tumbes, found ship  
Henry of Nantucket and bark  
Phileas of Stonington laying there  
the Hydrophy came in on the 7

Friday Oct 23<sup>rd</sup> Commenced with fresh breezes  
at 4 P.M. took the anchor into  
a proceaded, to sea, left several  
merchant vessels laying at anchor  
middle and latter part light breezes  
at 11 P.M. backed to the Eastward, so ends  
these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 5. 58

Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> Commenced with light breezes, head  
up S. E. by E. at 10 P.M. backed off  
at daylight a Merchant ship  
standing in, at 11 P.M. backed  
in, so ends these 24 hours  
Latitude by Obs. 5. 40

Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> Commenced with light breezes  
at 1 P.M. loosed one boat after  
black fish, struck two and  
drew the Iron, at 10 P.M. backed  
to the South, at 9 P.M. saw black  
board after them struck and saved  
it, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude  
by Obs. 6. 11

Monday 26<sup>th</sup> Commenced with light breezes  
at 4 P.M. backed to the Eastward  
at 10 P.M. backed to the Westward  
latter part calm, so ends these  
24 hours Latitude by Obs. 6. 30

Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> Commenced with light air, at 1 P.M.  
wore ship to the Eastward, saw  
a brig standing to the Northward,  
at 10 P.M. backed to the South,  
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude  
by Obs. 6. 44
