at 5 P.M. spoke Bark Edward of
New Bedford 5th months out 170 Hk
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude

Friday 20th Commencis with light trades and fine
weather, at 5 P.M. tacked to the east-
ward, at 6 A.M. saw a large sperm whale
a head of the ship bound to windward
board after him and got him at
9 A.M. got the whale a longside of
the ship and commenced cutting,
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs. 12.42 Long 83.30

Saturday 21st Commencis with fresh trades
and fine weather, at 5 P.M. finish-
ed cutting the whale, and com-
menced boiling, at 10 A.M. saw a sail off
the weather beam, so ends these 24
hours, Latitude by Obs. 12.08

Sunday 22 Commencis with fresh trades, at 11
A.M. saw a barque off the weather
beam, middle and latter part
the same, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs. 14.56

Monday 23 Commencis with fresh breezes
at 5 P.M. spoke Bark Caroline
of London 32 months out 1200 Hk
at 7 P.M. finished boiling, so ends
these 24 hours, No Obs.

Tuesday 24th Commencis with fresh trades and
over cast weather, at 5 P.M. wore ship
to the eastward, middle and latter
part the same, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs. 12.27 Long 81.59

Wednesday 25 Commencis with fresh trades and
over cast weather, at 6 A.M. wore ship
to the south, saw blackfish and
fin backs, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs. 12.17

Thursday 26 Commencis with fresh trades
and fine weather, at 9 A.M. saw
sperm whales off the sea beam
bound all ways, board after them
they perceived the boats and went
off to windward, saw the Caroline
off the sea beam, so ends these
24 hours, Latitude by Obs.
13.04 Long 82.48

Friday 27 Commencis with moderate trades
and fine weather, middle and latter
part strong breezes, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs. 13.06 Long 82.57

Saturday 28 Commencis with strong breezes at
5.40 P.M. spoke the Caroline, at
daylight broke out the main
hatch way and stowed down the
oil, so ends these 24 hours
No Obs.
