

Sunday Nov 29 Commencis with fresh breezes and overcast weather, middle and latter part light breezes, saw black-fish, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 13. 47

Monday 30th Commencis with light breezes and fine weather, middle and latter part the same, at 10 P.M. wore ship to the eastward, at 9.30 A.M. saw a large sperm whale a head of the ship going E.S.E. board after him and got him, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude 13. 26 Long 83. 20

Tuesday Dec 1st Commencis with light breezes at 3.30 P.M. got the whale a long side of the ship at 5 P.M. Commenced cutting, at noon finished and secured by the wind to the eastward, the Caroline in sight off the weather beam, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 13. 20

Wednesday 2nd Commencis with fresh breezes and cloudy weather, middle and latter part light breezes, at mid night wore ship to the south, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 13. 27

Thursday 3rd Commencis with light breezes, at 6 P.M. wore ship to the eastward, at 7 Past a Brig steering W by S, middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs 13. 08

Friday 4th Commencis with fresh breezes, at 5 P.M. spoke the Caroline, at 7 P.M. spoke ship Hector of New Bedford, 35 months out 1600 bbls of sperm oil, middle and latter part light breezes, saw one humpback, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs 12. 33

Saturday 5th Commencis with moderate breezes at 6 P.M. wore ship to the S.W., middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 13. 01 Long 81. 26

Sunday 6th Commencis with fresh breezes, at 4 P.M. past the Hector standing to the eastward, middle and latter part the same, at 2 A.M. wore ship to the eastward, at 9.30 A.M. past the Hector and the Caroline, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 12. 53

Monday 7th Commencis with strong breezes, at 4 P.M. wore ship to the south, at daylight commenced bracing out the after hole to stow down the oil, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 13. 26

Tuesday 8th Commencis with strong breezes, at 6 P.M. wore ship to the eastward, middle and latter part light breezes, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 12. 53 Longitude 81. 03
