

Wednesday Dec 9th Commencis with light
trades and fine weather, At 6
P.M. spoke the Caroline, at 7
P.M. heard 3 whys, saw black
fish, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs. 12.59

Thursday 10th Commencis with fresh trades
at 6 P.M. took in sail and lay
with the head yards a back during
the night, headed to the south
at 6 A.M. wore ship to the Eastward
so ends these 24 hours, No Observation

Friday 11th Commencis with moderate trades, At
6 P.M. board one boat after black-
fish, could not strike one too shy
at 9 P.M. board one boat after black
fish, could not strike, so ends these
24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 12.47

Saturday 12th Commencis with light trades
at 6 P.M. board one boat after
black fish could not strike too
shy, middle and latter part the
same, so ends these 24 hours, Lat-
itude by Obs. 13.26

Sunday 13th Commencis with light airs, At
5 P.M. wore ship to the Eastward
middle and latter part the same
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs. 13.02 Long 81.25

Monday 14th Commencis with light trades and
fine weather, middle and latter part
fresh breezes, saw a plenty of black fish
Unbent the jib repaired it and bent
it again, also bent a new main top sail
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by
Obs. 12.17

Tuesday 15th Commencis with fresh trades, At
6 P.M. tacked to the south, middle
and latter part the same, at 9 A.M.
part a whole brig steering to the N.E.,
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by
Obs. 13.10 Long 80.29

Wednesday 16th Commencis with fresh trades, At
middle part the same latter
part light breezes, at noon tacked
to the south, so ends these 24
hours, Latitude by Obs. 12.34

Thursday 17th Commencis with light trades
middle and latter part strong
breezes, so ends these 24 hours
No Observation

Friday 18th Commencis with strong breezes,
At 4.30 P.M. tacked to the
Eastward, middle and latter part
the same, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Observation 13.31
Longitude 79.18
