these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs
14. 25

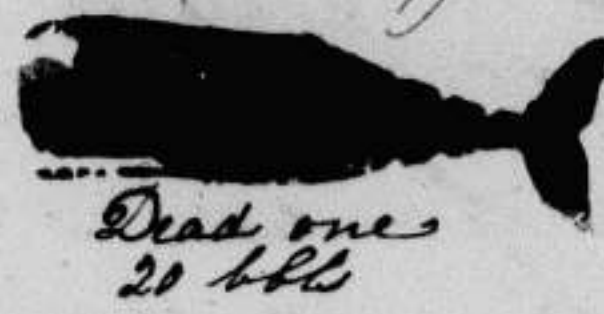
Saturday 2nd Commencis with light airs
middle and latter part the same
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs, 14. 42 Long 78. 42

Sunday 3rd Commencis with light trades and
pleasant weather, at 4 P.M. steered off
by 16, at daylight saw a sail standing
to the southward, so ends these 24
hours, Latitude by Obs, 13. 21

Monday 4th Commencis with light trades and
fine weather, middle and latter
part the same, at Noon buff too
by the wind to the southward,
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by
Obs, 12. 12, Long 80.

Tuesday 5th Commencis with light trades, and fine
weather, middle and latter part
the same, at 10 A.M. past a sperm
whale carcass, at Noon steered to 16,
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by
Obs, 13. 23

Wednesday 6th Commencis with light trades and
fine weather, at 6 P.M. saw a sperm
whale took it a long side, cut the
whale in, made 24 bls, so ends these
24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 13. 20
