

Friday Jan 8th Commencis with light trades and fine weather, at 9 P.M. spoke the Hector had seen nothing since we last saw her so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs 12.34

Saturday 9th Commencis with light airs, at 3 P.M. spoke the Hector, at 5 P.M. spoke ship Golconda of New Bedford 40 months out 1400 Obs, middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 12.51 Longitude 82.51

Sunday 10th Commencis with light trades middle and latter part strong breezes, at 3.40 P.M. spoke and boarded the Golconda, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 13.42

Monday 11th Commencis with strong trades at 6 P.M. wore ship to the N.E. middle and latter part more moderate, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 13.25 Long 83.14

Tuesday 12th Commencis with fresh trades and latter part moderate trades, at 7 A.M. steered N.W. by E, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 12.21

Wednesday 13th Commencis with fresh trades and fine weather, middle and latter part light breezes, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs 10.47 Long 81.23

Thursday 14th Commencis with fresh trades and fine weather, steering N.W. by E, at noon steered N.W. by W, saw a brig bound down the coast, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 9.20 Long 80.54

Friday 15th Commencis with light trades, at 4 P.M. board a boat and sent letters on board of the brig to be left at Paita, middle and latter part light airs so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 7.54 Long 80.59

Saturday 16th Commencis with light airs, steering N.W. by W, at midnight lay with the head yards a back at day light steered N.W. by E, at 11 A.M. saw the Lobos Lobos so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 7.13 Long 80.48

Sunday 17th Commencis with light airs, at 5 P.M. steered N.W. by E, middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs 6.55

Monday 18th Commencis with light airs, at 2 P.M. saw two brigs steering by the wind to the eastward, middle and latter part fresh trades, saw blackfish, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 6.48 South
