

Wednesday March 3rd Commencis with light
trades, At 4 P.M. wind AB and pleasant
weather, at 4 A.M. backed to the East
ward, wind SE, latter part fresh
breezes, so ends these 24 hours -
Latitude by Obs - 48 miles North
Longitude 82° 40'

Thursday 4th Commencis with light air
and fine weather, middle part
the same latter part fresh breezes
at 7 A.M. backed to the Eastward
At 8.30 A.M. saw breaches off the
Sea bow which proved to be sperm
whales going quick to windward,
At 10 A.M. aboard after the whales
so ends boats off Chasing, Latitude
by Obs - 25 miles N Long 83° 00'

Friday 5th Commencis with light trades and
fine weather, struck two whales
and got them, got Larboard boat
badly stove, at daylight Commenced
cutting at 10 A.M. finished, so ends
these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs
2 miles North

Saturday 6th Commencis with light trades
and fine weather, middle part
the same latter part fresh breezes
At Noon wore ship to the Eastward
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs - 21 miles South Longitude
83° 20'

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Sunday 7th Commencis with moderate breezes
and fine weather, middle and
latter part light air, finished
boiling, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs - 16 miles South

Monday 8th Commencis with light air, At
4.40 P.M. saw a sail a head could
not ascertain what he was, middle
and latter part calm, so ends these
24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 17 miles S
Longitude, 82° 18'

Tuesday 9th Commencis with a calm, middle part
light air from the North, latter
part calm, so ends these 24 hours -
Latitude by Obs - 9 miles South

Wednesday 10th Commencis with light air from
the North, middle and latter
part light trades, finished stowing
down the oil, so ends these 24
hours, Latitude by Obs, 36 miles S
Longitude 82° 58'

Thursday 11th Commencis with light trades
at 6 P.M. backed to the Eastward
middle and latter part the same,
At Noon backed to the South
ward, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs - 31 miles South
