

Wednesday April 21st Commencis with fresh trades, At 3 P.M. bent a new gill, middle and latter part the same so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 12. 22

Thursday 22 Commencis with fresh trades. middle part the same latter part wind E by S so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 11. 49 Longitude 79. 22

Friday 23 Commencis with fresh breezes. At 4 P.M. tacked to the south. At 2 A.M. tacked to the eastward so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 11. 37 Longitude 78. 57

Saturday 24 Commencis with fresh trades middle and latter part the same tacked a bout to the best advantage so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 11. 52 Long 78. 24

Sunday 25 Commencis with strong trades middle and latter part light breezes. At 11 A.M. hoard after a sword fish struck him and drew the iron. so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 11. 52

Monday 26 Commencis with light trades

Tuesday May 22nd Commencis with strong trades At 6 P.M. left Paita in company with ships Henry & Enterprise of Nantucket, at Noon steered N.W. so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 4. 12

Wednesday 23 Commencis with strong trades middle and latter part more moderate, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 2. 54

Thursday 24 Commencis with moderate trades and fine weather middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 1. 55 Long 85. 10

Friday 25 Commencis with light breezes and fine weather, at 4 P.M. saw breeches off the weather bow, soon after saw a shoal of sperm whales off the sea beam, Round, 2 Boats after them got up with them at sundown. They perceived the boats and went off to board. Tacked a bout in hopes of seeing them again but did not so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 1. 40. 5 Longitude 86. 4

Saturday 26 Commencis with fresh breezes and fine weather, at 1 P.M. the ship Charles Frederick of New Bedford past us, at 6.40 A.M. saw a shoal of sperm whales. The Charles Frederick having the chance got one, chased the whales off to windward but of no use, so ends, Lat 1. 29 Long 85. 50
