

Thursday 27 Commencis with light breezes and pleasant weather, Tacked about in hopes of seeing the whales, At Noon past the Enterprise of Nant, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. $1^{\circ} 29'$ Long $85^{\circ} 93'$ W

Friday 28 Commencis with light trades, At 1 P.M. saw breeches off the weather bow, which proved to be sperm whale Tacked about to the best advantage after them, at 5.20 P.M. hoard two boats after them, but night coming on came on board, Tacked about in hopes of seeing them again but did not, saw two ships, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. $1^{\circ} 17'$ Long $85^{\circ} 23'$

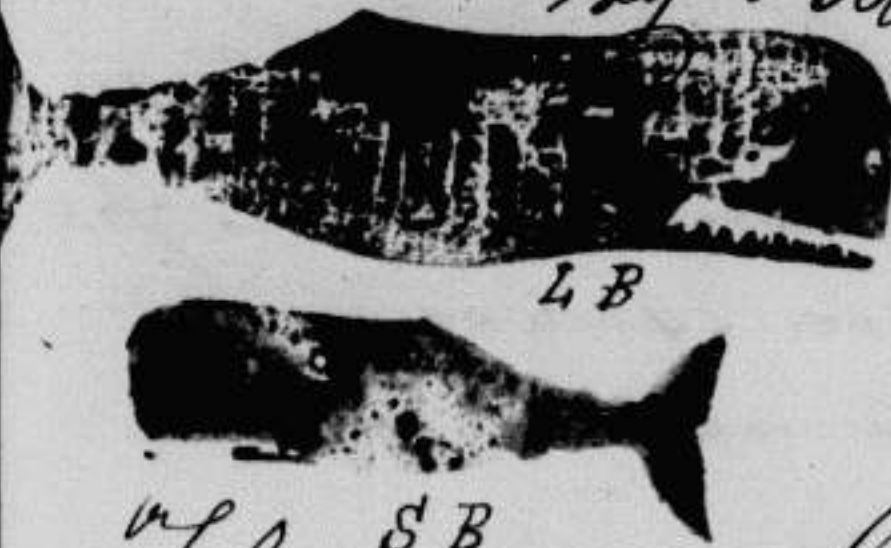
Saturday 29 Commencis with fresh breezes, middle and latter part light breezes saw blackfish, so ends these 24 hours Latitude, $1^{\circ} 32'$

Sunday 30 Commencis with light trades and fine weather, middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. $1^{\circ} 08'$ Long $84^{\circ} 55'$

Monday 31 Commencis with light trades, middle and latter part fresh breezes, at 7 P.M. spoke the Charles Frederick. Had taken 100 bbls since leaving ballas, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. $1^{\circ} 27'$

Tuesday June 1st Commencis with fresh trades and fine weather, middle and latter part light breezes, so ends these 24 hours. No Observation

Wednesday 2th Commencis with light breezes, at 2.40 P.M. saw a large sperm whale a head of the ship going a bout N.W. hoard after him and got him, at 6 P.M. saw a shoal of small ones, hoard after them and got a small one, employed in butting, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 41 miles south



Thursday 3 Commencis with fresh breezes, at 4.30 P.M. got the whales in, and steered by the wind to the eastwards, middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 34 miles S Long $85^{\circ} 18'$ W

Friday 4 Commencis with fresh trades middle and latter part the same, at 11 A.M. past the Caldao whaling brig, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude 30 miles south Long $84^{\circ} 42'$

Saturday 5 Commencis with fresh trades, working to windward to the best advantage middle and latter part light breezes at Noon finished boiling the whales 100 bbls, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 42 miles S Long $85^{\circ} 54'$
