

Sunday June 6th Commencis with light trades
The Callao Brig in sight, middle and
latter part the same, so ends these 24
hours, Latitude by Obs. 14 miles South

Monday 7th Commencis with light trades, middle
and latter part the same, finished stow-
ing off the main Hatch way, so ends
these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 13 miles
S Long 84.50

Tuesday 8th Commencis with light trades and
fine weather, middle and latter part
the same, so ends these 24 hours,
Latitude by Obs. 23 miles S

Wednesday 9th Commencis with light trades,
working to windward to the best
advantage, middle and latter part
the same, so ends these 24 hours,
Latitude by Obs. 10 miles South

Thursday 10th Commencis with light trades, At
4.40 P.M. saw a ship off the weather
beam, At 11 A.M. spoke ship Stee of
New Bedford, 950 bbls so ends these
24 hours, Lat 14 miles S Long 85.00

Friday 11th Commencis with light trades, At 4.30
P.M. the bye saw a shoal of sperm whales
going quick to the S.W. board after
them, but night coming on could not
get too near, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs. 16 miles S

Saturday 12th Commencis with light trades, working
about to the best advantage, working to
windward, At midnight past two ships
boiling, 5 other ships in sight, so
ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs.
16 miles North

Sunday 13th Commencis with fresh trades, at 2.30
P.M. saw breechies off the weather beam
which proved to be sperm whales, At
3 board for them, The whales saw
or heard the boats and started to wind-
ward, soon after altered their course
and went off to board, got up with
them and missed one of them, at 6.30
P.M. spoke ship Formosa of New Bedford
1500 bbls, 350 of it sperm, at 9 A.M. spoke
ship George Howland of New Bedford
300 sperm, 11 1/2 months out, so ends
these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 2 miles S

Monday 14th Commencis with fresh trades and
clear weather, middle and latter
part the same, so ends these 24 hours
No Observation

Tuesday 15th Commencis with strong trades,
working to windward to the best
advantage, middle and latter part
the same, so ends these 24 hours,
Latitude by Obs. 32 miles S Long 85.15

Wednesday 16th Commencis with fresh trades, working
to windward to the best advantage,
middle and latter part the same
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by
Obs. 45 miles S Long 85.00
