

Monday 12th Commencis with light trades and fine weather, At 5 P.M. hoard after black fish but could not strike, At 8 P.M. spoke ship *Hope* of New Bedford, Had seen nothing since we last spoke her, At 6 A.M. saw a sail off the weather bow, At 4 P.M. No saw breeches which proved to be Hump back, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 1.02 N Longitude 85.30

Tuesday 13th Commencis with fresh trades and fine weather, middle and latter part light breezes, saw Breeches could not ascertain what they were, so ends these 24 hours No Observation

Wednesday 14th Commencis with light trades, middle and latter part the same steering N.E., so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs, 25 miles N Long 83.4

Thursday 15th Commencis with fresh trades steering N.E., saw one Hump back so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 1.50 N Long 82.43

Friday 16th Commencis with fresh trades At 1.40 P.M. saw a school of sperm whales going N by E. hoard after them and got a calf, At 10 A.M. saw breeches which proved to be sperm whales going quick to the South, hoard after them but could not get up with them, so ends these 24 hours. No Observation

Saturday 17th Commencis with strong trades, At 6.30 A.M. saw Breeches off the weather beam, Tacked about in hopes of seeing them a gain but did not, saw three ships, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs, 1.57 Long 82.45

Sunday 18th Commencis with strong trades, at 7 P.M. spoke ship *Java* off Fair Haven Had taken since we last spoke her 200 bbls, At 7 A.M. saw three ships one of them a Merchant ship bound to the N.W., so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 1.38 N Longitude 81.36

Monday 19th Commencis with strong trades, middle and latter part the same, saw two ships, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs, 1.30 N

Tuesday 20th Commencis with strong trades, middle and latter part moderate breezes and fine weather, one ship in sight, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 1.27 N Long 82.9

Wednesday 21st Commencis with fresh trades and fine weather, middle part the same latter part squally with rain, No Observation this day
