

Thursday August 12th Commenceis with strong trades steering by the wind to the South middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 2.32 Long 101.27

Friday 13th Commenceis with strong trades and squally weather, steering by the wind to the Southwards, middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 4.01 Long 102.39 W

Saturday 14th Commenceis with strong trades and clear weather, middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 5.29 Long 103.54

Sunday 15th Commenceis with strong trades, At 6 P.M. wore ship and steerd North, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Observation 5.13 Long 104.54

Monday 16th Commenceis with strong trades At 3 P.M. saw a large sperm whale off the sea bow going about E by S. Board after him but of no use the whale went quick under water, middle and latter part fresh breezes, repaired a fore topsail and bent it for a main one so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Observation 5.09 Long 104.57

Tuesday 17th Commenceis with strong trades middle and latter part more moderate and fine weather, steering about but it seems all in vain, so ends Another unfortunate day, Latitude by Obs. 5.9 Long 104.537

Wednesday 18th Commenceis with fresh breezes and fine weather, middle and latter part moderate and fine weather, At 10 P.M. steerd S by W, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 5.00

Thursday 19th Commenceis with fresh trades At 3 P.M. saw a Merchant ship or Man o'war about N by W, middle and latter part the same, saw breaches off the weather beam, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 5.21 Long 106.15

Friday 20th Commenceis with strong trades and squally, steering by the wind to the N.E. At 7 A.M. saw a shoal of sperm whales going to windward, board after them after chasing some time struck one and got him. At Noon got the whale a long side of the ship and kept off for him that went off to board, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 4.14 Long 106.

Saturday 21st Commenceis with moderate trades and fine weather, At 2 P.M. saw the whale again board after them and got 2 more, At 3.40 P.M. got them a long side of the ship, At Daylight Commenced cutting At 10.40 At 6 finished and wore ship to the South, so ends these 24 hours, Lat. 4.21 Long 106.5
