

Tuesday Sept 14th Commencis with light breezes from the southward, Heeded A.M. middle and latter part the same, Unbent the old flying gib and bent the old one, so ends these 24 hours - Latitude by Obs. 1.42 North Long 110.2

Wednesday 15 Commencis with light trades and fine weather, middle and latter part strong breezes, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 3.27 N

Thursday 16 Commencis with strong trades, At 9.16 luff too by the wind to the eastward, At Daylight wore ship to the southward, Repaired the main top sail and bent it, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 3.46 Long 110.18

Friday 17 Commencis with strong trades, At 5.16 wore ship to the S.W., middle and latter part light breezes and fine weather, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 4.07 N Long 109.33

Saturday 18 Commencis with light breezes middle and latter part the same. Steering East, so ends these 24 hours - Latitude by Obs. 4.16 Long 108.44

Sunday 19 Commencis with light breezes from the southward, middle and latter part fresh breezes, so ends these 24 hours - Latitude by Obs. 4.04 N

Monday 20th Commencis with fresh breezes from the southward, Heed up East, middle and latter part the same, Bent a new fore, top galant sail, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 4.00 Long 105.53

Tuesday 21 Commencis with strong trades, middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 4.14 Long 104.43

Wednesday 22 Commencis with fresh trades and fine weather, middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 4.19 N

Thursday 23 Commencis with fresh breezes. Heed up S.W., middle and latter part the same, At 11.30 A.M. saw sperm whales off the sea beam hoard after them, struck two and took them to the ship, Parted from them and lost one of them, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 3.46 Long 101.28

Friday 24th Commencis with light breezes, At 6 P.M. got the whale a long side of the ship and lay by him during the night, At daylight commenced cutting at 7. Finished and steered by the wind to the eastward. At 10 A.M. wore ship to the S.W., so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Observation 3.46 Longitude 100.53
