them, so ends these 24 hours, Boats

Monday 8th Commencis with fresh breezes.
At 3 P.M. struck a large whale close
to ship, soon after the boat to wind
ward struck a fifty barrel whale and
got him. The large whale appeared
to be an eating chap and lost him after
getting the starboard boat stove, At
daylight commenced cutting the whale
at 10 A.M. finished and steered by the
wind to the south, so ends these 24
hours, No Observation this day.

Tuesday 9th Commencis with light trades
and fine weather, At 2 P.M.
saw a large sperm whale ~~going~~
going quick to the N.W. board
pursued him and got him, At 6 P.M.
got him a long side of the ship
at daylight commenced cutting.
L. B. McEwen Noon got the body in, so ends
24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 6.23

Wednesday 10th Commencis with light trades
and fine weather, At 4 P.M. finished
cutting and steered by the wind to the
south, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs. 7.4.

Thursday 11th Commencis with light trades
and fine weather, steering by the
wind to the south, middle and latter
part some fog, finished the starboard
boat and put her on the crains, so ends
these 24 hours, No Observation this day

Friday 12th Commencis with light trades, steering
by the wind to the southward, middle
and latter part the same, so ends these
24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 8.23 Long 86.24

Saturday 13th Commencis with light trades
and fine weather, At 5 P.M. finished
boiling out the whales, at 16 P.M. wore
ship to the eastward, middle and latter
part the same, so ends these 24 hours.
Latitude by Obs. 8.10 Long 86.34

Sunday 14th Commencis with light trades and
fine weather, middle and latter part
the same, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs. 7.42 Long 85.18

Monday 15th Commencis with light trades and fine
weather, steering by the wind to the
eastward, middle and latter part the
same, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs. 7.9

Tuesday 16th Commencis with light trades and
fine weather, At 6 P.M. sacked to the
south, Employed coopering the oil
to stow, so ends these 24 hours
Latitude by Obs. 6.38
