

Wednesday April 5 Commencis with a Calm  
middle part the same, latter part strong  
breezes from N.W. to S.W. with some  
rain, stowed down the oil in the fore  
hold, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude  
by Obs, 34.17

Thursday 6 Commencis with strong breezes  
from S.W., steering by the wind to  
the S.E., middle part light breezes from  
S.E. latter part strong breezes from the  
S.E., At 7 A.M. wore ship to the S.W., so ends  
these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 34.50  
Longitude 74.41

Friday 7 Commencis with strong breezes from  
the South, At 4 P.M. Tacked to the East  
ward, middle part wind S.W., latter  
part S.W., saw one sail, so ends these  
24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 35.10 Longitude  
74.50

Saturday 8 Commencis with fresh breezes  
from N.W., steering S.E., middle  
and latter part strong breezes from  
N.W. to N.E., and a squally of rain  
so ends these 24 hours, No Observations

Sunday 9th Commencis with strong gale to  
the N.W., middle part more moderate  
wind N.W., latter part calm with  
a bad swell on, At 2.40 A.M. past  
a sail steering N.E., so ends these  
24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 37.07  
Longitude 74.14

Monday 10 Commencis with light airs from the  
S.W., At 1 P.M. saw the Island of St. Maria  
bearing East at Daylight steered off S.E.  
for Taleahuan, so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday 11 Commencis with fresh breezes from  
the S.W., at 4.30 P.M. past by our ship  
at 10 P.M. come too off Sirguin,

Wednesday 22 Commencis with light southerly  
winds, At 2 P.M. took the Anchor  
and steered down the bay, At 9  
P.M. took a light breeze from the  
North, at 2 A.M. calm, so ends these  
24 hours, Latitude

Thursday 23 Commencis with light breezes from  
the North middle and latter part  
the same, so ends these 24 hours,  
No Observation the Land 28 miles off

Monday 24 Commencis with light breezes  
from the Northward and thick rainy  
weather, At 3 P.M. saw a sperm whale  
close to the ship, After the whale  
went down board the boats. soon  
after saw several whales going different  
ways, At sundown struck a 50 lb  
whale got a boat stove and right  
coming on lost the whale, At five  
o'clock to have got some oil if we  
had had day time for it, middle part  
calm, latter part fresh breezes from  
the South, steered S.W. by N., so ends  
these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs,  
35.59
