

Wednesday June 14th Commencis with fresh breezes At 1 P.M. tacked to the Westward, At 3 P.M. past a berg standing to the Eastward, At 4 A.M. saw the spermnet saying a back soon after saw her boats off in chase of a large sperm whale, heard her boats but of no use, so ends the whale gone to windward, Latitude by Obs. 2. 24 N Long 82. 6

Thursday 15 Commencis with light breeze At 1 P.M. tacked to the Eastward At 5.30 P.M. tacked to the Westward At 7 A.M. tacked to the Eastward so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 2. 11 Long 82. 41

Friday 16 Commencis with light airs at 1 P.M. wore ship to the Westward At 6.30 P.M. wore back to the S.E., At 10 P.M. tacked to the Westward middle and latter part, fresh breeze so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 2. 01 N Long 83. 25

Saturday 17 Commencis with fresh breeze At 10 P.M. tacked to the Eastward middle and latter part fresh breezes so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 1. 27 N Longitude 82. 57

Sunday 18th Commencis with fresh trade At 4 P.M. tacked to the Westward, middle and latter part, fresh trades, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 1. 23 N Long 84. 25

Monday 19th Commencis with strong trades and thick foggy weather, middle and latter part more moderate, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 1. 18 Long 85. 25

Tuesday 20 Commencis with moderate trades and fine weather, At 4.30 P.M. tacked to the Eastward, At 6.30 A.M. saw a shoal of sperm whales off the weather beam going to the Eastward, heard after them and got 2, At 11 A.M. got them a long side of the ship, so ends these 24 hours, Lat 85 miles N Long 84. 45

Wednesday 21 Commencis with light trades middle and latter part strong breezes At 2 A.M. wore ship to the Westward so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 42 miles N Long 84. 35

Thursday 22 Commencis with strong trades At 5 P.M. wore ship to the Eastward At daylight saw a ship off the lee beam standing to the Eastward, Finished bolting out the 4 Bales so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 24 miles N
