

Friday October 6th Commencis with strong breezes from N. N. W. At Midnight the wind hauled to the South and moderated down. Latter part light airs and calms, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 42.41 Long 77.56

Saturday 7th Commencis with a calm, middle part the same Latter part light airs from the North, steered South, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 42.39 Longitude 78.02

Sunday 8th Commencis with light breezes from N. N. W. Middle part wind to N. N. E. Latter part strong breezes from North to N. N. E., steering S. by N. so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 44.27 Longitude 79.00

Monday 9th Commencis with strong winds from the North, At 11 P.M. steered E. middle and latter part strong gale from N. N. E., so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 47.01

Tuesday 10th Commencis with strong gails from N. N. E., middle part the same Latter part light breezes and a pleasant weather wind E. by N. so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 49.25 Longitude 80.11

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Wednesday 11th Commencis with light breezes and fine weather, middle and latter part strong breezes from the Eastward steering by the wind to the Southward so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 51.12 South

Thursday 12th Commencis with strong breezes from the Eastward, middle part calm Latter part fresh breezes from the North At 6 A.M. saw a big steering by the wind to the Westward, so ends these 24 hours Latitude by Obs. 52.26

Friday 13th Commencis with strong gails from the North, steering S. by E. At 4 P.M. carried away fore topmast steering sail boom, At 7 P.M. took in fore and main top sails, Doubt we reached the main At 6 A.M. saw a Bark laying too head to the Westward, Middle part wind from N. by N. West, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 55.00 Longitude 79.55

Saturday 14th Commencis with strong gails from N. N. E. to West, At 3 P.M. signalled an American whaling Bark showing a white signal with red borders blue Ball in the Center and blue tail, Middle and latter part the same, so ends these 24 hours. No observation

Sunday 15th Commencis with strong gails from N. N. E. At 1 P.M. a sea struck the S. B. and unhooked the after tackle and stove the Boat Badley or about used her up, middle and latter part the same so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 56.52 Longitude 72.34
