

Friday Oct 27th Commencis with strong breezes from S.W., middle and latter part light breezes, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 41.55 South

Saturday 28 Commencis with light breezes from the south, steering N.E. by N. middle and latter part calm, so ends these 24 hours, sent down the Mizen topsail repaired it and bent it again, Latitude by Obs. 41.55

Sunday 29 Commencis with a calm, middle part the same, latter part strong breezes from N.E., At daylight saw a large ship off the weather beam bound to the south, At 9 A.M. saw another off the weather bow which proved to be the New Bedford of New Bedford 5 months out to sperm had shipped it home from the Islands, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude 42.34 Long 53.35

Monday 30th Commencis with fresh breeze from N.E., At 1.30 P.M. wore ship to the westward, middle and latter part thick weather, so ends. No Observ

Tuesday 31 Commencis with light breezes and thick weather, latter part strong breezes from W.S.W. to S.W., so ends.

Wednesday November 1st Commencis with strong breezes from the W.S.W. middle part light latter part calm, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 40.13 Long 52.34

Thursday 2 Commencis with light breezes from the Eastward and rain in abundance, steering by the wind to the Northward. At Midnight wind hauled out sudden to the S.W. with strong squalls, At 1 P.M. latter part more moderate, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 39.02 Longitude 49.50

Friday 3rd Commencis with strong breezes from N.W. At 4 P.M. took in sail and head up North by the wind, middle and latter part light breezes from N.W. steering by the wind to the N.E. so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 38.42

Saturday 4th Commencis with light breezes from N.W., middle and latter part calm, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 38.29, Took up the Shear off the Deck.

Sunday 5th Commencis with a calm, middle part light breezes from N.W., latter part strong breezes from N.E. steering by the wind to the Eastward, so ends these 24 hours. Latitude by Obs. 38.10 Long 46.44

Monday 6th Commencis with strong breezes from N.E., At 8 P.M. took in fore and mizen topsails and foresail, At Midnight the wind died away and hauled out to the S.W. steering N by W, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs. 37.29
