Friday December 1st Commencis with light
breezes from S.E. to East, with some rain, steering
by the wind, middle and latter part wind N.E. by
N. 9 A.M. spoke Bark Robble
of Boston bound South, saw a Brig bound
N. by the S.W. so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs, 9° 53' Long 33° 45'

Saturday 2nd Commencis with light breezes
from S.E. steering by the wind to the North
Middle and latter part wind N.E. saw 4 sail
the land, and several Cadamarans, so ends these
24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 8° 21' Long 34° 32'

Sunday 3rd Commencis with light breezes
from East, At sun set heird a frigate
laying at Burnumbuca dressed off with
steering a salute, middle and latter part
wind S.E. steering by the wind to the North
the land 20 miles distant, so ends these 24
Latitude by Obs, 6° 45'

Monday 4th Commencis with light breezes
from S.E. middle part the same, latter
part wind E. by N. At 11 P.M. spoke
Bark bound to New York, At noon saw
a boat and bought a mess of fish from
a balser, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs, 4° 58' the land in sight

Tuesday 5th Commencis with fresh breezes from
E. by N. steering N. by N. Middle and latter part
wind S.E. by E. At 6 P.M. spoke Bark bound N. by N. so ends
these 24 hours Latitude by Obs, 2° 47' South

Wednesday 6th Commencis with fresh trades
and fine weather, blew off the larboard
side of the ship, for painting, painted the
larboard side, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Obs, 53 miles South Longitude 38° 35'

Thursday 7th Commencis with fresh trades
At 6 P.M. steered N. by N. Middle and latter
part the same, so ends these 24 hours, Latitude
by Observation 55 miles N. Long 40° 1'

Friday 8th Commencis with light trades
At 6 P.M. steered N. by N. Middle and latter
part the same, steering the ship out side
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs,
2° 21' Longitude 41° 29'

Saturday 9th Commencis with light breezes
from E. by N. middle and latter part the same
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Obs, 3° 25' Long 42° 25'

Sunday 10th Commencis with light breezes from
E. by N. steering N. by N. Middle and latter
part the same, At 6 P.M. saw a sail, a boat
so ends these 24 hours, Latitude by Observation
4° 53' Longitude 43° 20'

Monday 11th Commencis with light breezes from
East E. by N. At 5 P.M. steered N. by N. middle part the
same, latter part wind N. by N. found the
compass, and a plenty of rain, so ends
these 24 hours No Observation
