

Monday September 23rd Lat 40-05 N Long 74
 first part of this day light airs from the Northward
 standing on the Westward tack, at 8 A.M. took
 ship at 9 lowered a boat and sounded 42 fathoms
 Muddy Bottom at 10 the wind got round to the
 Westward steering a course of all sail set
 employed in ship, stop at half a past 3 P.M. raised
 the land on the Weatherbow and ahead, heading
 for Montez Point, at 6 raised Block Island,
 bearing N.E. by N. at 12 P.M. it bore 3 Points forward
 of the Beam 15 Miles distance.

Tuesday September 24th
 first Middle and latter part of this day baffling
 airs at 7 P.M. until 9 fresh breezes from the N.E.
 were then within 15 Miles of B Island & N.E. from
 it at 11 P.M. Cuttyhunk and the lighthouse and
 Payhead were plain in sight. Moderate and pleasant
 light airs from the N.E. Spoke a Pilot Boat of
 Block Island and got some Paper.

Wednesday September 25th
 this day light breezes at 1 P.M. were abreast
 Cuttyhunk, took a breeze from the S.E. at half
 a past 9 were within 3 Miles of Bird Island,
