

Wednesday 13th blowing fresh with squalls from the Westward all sail set steering ESE latter part squally and rugged wind hauling to the NW at 4 P.M. set Foretop sail and Gafftop sail which were hoisted during the night
Lat 34-15 N Long by Chron 35-19 W

Thursday 14th blowing fresh with squalls from the NW steering E by S at 2 P.M. reefed the Fore and Main topsails at 4 set the Flying jib. Middle and latter part moderate all sail set wind hauling to the Westward
Lat 34-02 N Long by Chron 34-02 W

Friday Jan 15th fine breezes and pleasant from the S.W. steering E by S all sail set employed in ship's duty but very little Sulfur weed in sight Middle and latter part fresh breezes all sail set
Lat 34-34 N Long by dead reck 31-30 W

Saturday Jan 16th blowing fresh with squalls at 1 P.M. wind hauled to the NW took in the Gafftop sail and reefed the Fore and Main topsails. Breathing out fresh water one tub. Reefed latter part squally under short sail with E heading S.E. by the Wind. Lat 33-47 N Long 30-00 W by Chron

Sunday Jan 17th blowing fresh with squalls from the E. and E. heading S.E. by the Wind at 4 P.M. turned the reef out the Main topsail and set the Flying jib and Gafftop sail Middle and latter part light baffling air and raining Wind S and S.E. all sail set employed in ship's duty No Sulfur weed in sight. Lat 33-15 N Long 29-15 W

Monday Jan 18th first part of this day light air from the S and S.E. steering E by S and E. S.E. all sail set. Squally with some rain at 6 P.M. chose the Boats crewed. Latter part fresh breeze and squally at 10 P.M. spoke the Bark Enterprise of Liverpool. Bound to Bermudas had sailed the Cape Verde Medary Island a few days previous. By Longitude 23-14 W
Lat 33-38 N Long by Chron 24-14 W

Tuesday Jan 19th fresh breezes from the S and S.W. steering S.E. by E at 5 P.M. took in the Gafftop sail and put one reef in the Foretop sail. Saw a Ship steering NW. Latter part light breezes all sail set wind hauling to the Eastward. Saw a Brig steering to the Westward.
Lat 34-19 N Long by Chron 20-36 W

Wednesday Jan 20th fresh breezes and pleasant Wind from the Eastward at 1 P.M. took Ship heading S and S.E. at 4 P.M. put the Waist boat on the crane and the Starboard Boat on the crane. Middle and latter part squally took in the Gafftop sail heading S.E. by the Wind. Saw a Bark steering S.W.
Lat 32-38 N Long by Chron 19-19 W

Thursday Jan 21st blowing fresh with squalls from the Eastward heading S.E. by the Wind at 2 P.M. put one reef in the Foretop sail. Saw a Ship steering S.W. Saw a school of porpoises. Middle and latter part pleasant wind S.E. heading S.W. all sail set.
